ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MAPLETON, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGE FOR LABORERS, WORKMEN AND MECHANICS EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE VILLAGE OF MAPLETON

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, Village or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended (820 ILCS 130/1 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Village of Mapleton of the County of Peoria investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said Peoria County employed in performing construction of public works, for said Village of Mapleton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Village Board of the Village of Mapleton:

Section 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by state, county, Village or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Mapleton is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Peoria County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June of the current year, which such rate was last published for September 2017, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the department's September determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Village of Mapleton. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

Section 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village of Mapleton to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

Section 3: The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village of Mapleton this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

Section 4: The Village Clerk of the Village of Mapleton shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

fall on a Sunday is celebrated on the following Monday. This then makes work performed on that Monday payable at the appropriate overtime The following list is considered as those days for which holiday rates of wages for work performed apply: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and Veterans Day in some classifications/counties. Generally, any of these holidays which rate for holiday pay. Common practice in a given local may alter certain days of celebration. If in doubt, please check with IDOL.

Oil and chip resealing (O&C) means the application of road oils and liquid asphalt to coat an existing road surface, followed by application of aggregate chips or gravel to coated surface, and subsequent rolling of material to seal the surface.

EXPLANATION OF CLASSES

jackhammer & drill operator, gunite pump & pot man, puddlers, vibrator men, wire fabric placer, sandblast pump & pot man, strike off concrete, brickset-ters, cutting torchman (electric & acetylene), men setting lines to level forms, form setters, gunite nozzle man & sandblasting nozzle unloading, handling & carrying of all creosoted piles, ties or timber, concrete burning bars, power wheelbarrows or buggies, asphalt raker, The skilled laborer heavy & highway (HWY) classification shall encompass the following types of work,irrespective of the site of the work: man, power man, and rip-rapping by hand.

Class 4. Low Boy and Oil Distributors.

Class 5. Drivers who require special protective clothing while employed on hazardous waste work.

TRUCK DRIVER - OIL AND CHIP RESEALING ONLY.

This shall encompass laborers, workers and mechanics who drive contractor or subcontractor owned, leased, or hired pickup, dump, service, or machinery and tools) to or from the job site; distributing oil or liquid asphalt and aggregate; stock piling material when in connection with the oil distributor trucks. The work includes transporting materials and equipment (including but not limited to, oils, aggregate supplies, parts, actual oil and chip contract. The Truck Driver (Oil & Chip Resealing) wage classification does not include supplier delivered materials.

OPERATING ENGINEERS - BUILDING

Class 1. Cranes; Overhead Cranes; Gradall; All Cherry Pickers; Mechanics; Central Concrete Mixing Plant Operator; Road Pavers (27E - Dual Drum Scooper; Drag Lines; Backhoe; Derrick Boats; Pile Drivers and Skid Rigs; Clamshells; Locomotive Cranes; Dredge (all types) Motor Patrol; Power - Tri Batchers); Blacktop Plant Operators and Plant Engineers; 3 Drum Hoist; Derricks; Hydro Cranes; Shovels; Skimmer Scoops; Koehring

Section 5: The Village Clerk of the Village of Mapleton shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

<u>Section 6</u>: The Village Clerk of the Village of Mapleton shall cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form by keeping at least three (3) copies hereof available for public inspection, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.

<u>Section 7:</u> That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
