

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-12-14-01

VILLAGE OF MAPLETON, ILLINOIS

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18-3
(SERVICE CHARGES FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF RESIDENTIAL
WASTE) OF THE VILLAGE CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF MAPLETON, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 18-3 of the Village Code, Service Charges for Collection and Disposal of Residential Waste, shall be deleted in its entirety, and the following Section shall be substituted in its place:

18-3. Service Charges for Collection and Disposal of Residential Waste.

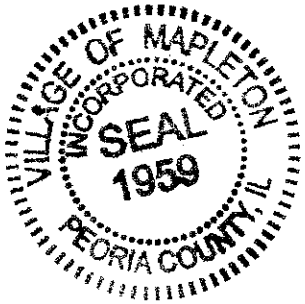
- A. There shall be and there is hereby established a service charge for the collection and disposal of Residential Waste in the amount of \$11.25 per month to be imposed on all Single-Family Dwellings within the Village.
- B. Said service charge for the collection and disposal of Residential Waste shall be payable monthly. The owner of the premises, the occupant thereof and the user of the service shall be jointly and severally liable to pay for the service to such premises and the service is furnished to the premises by the Village only upon the condition that the owner of the premises, occupant thereof and user of the service are jointly and severally liable therefore to the Village. Bills for service shall be sent out by the Village treasurer on the 1st day of the month succeeding the period for which the service is billed. All bills shall be collected in the same manner as set forth in Chapter 14 of the Village Code for the collection of water bills, and penalties shall be imposed for delinquent bills in the same manner as penalties for delinquent water bills are imposed pursuant to said Chapter 14.
- C. Upon garbage service application from a resident, a \$25.00 security deposit will be required. Security deposit will be returned to resident after 2 years of timely payments. Security deposit will be retained for the life of the account after 3 late payments.
- D. If, at any time, the contractor selected by the Village to collect residential waste imposes a fuel surcharge on the Village, the Village has the authority to impose a fuel surcharge on all Single-Family Dwellings within the Village in order to offset the fuel surcharge imposed by the contractor.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its passage and publication

as provided by law.
