YARD CLEANUP



DO NOT MOW OR DRIVE OVER the water meter vault as you may damage or destroy the transmitter. **DO NOT** cover meter vault/access with plants, rocks or landscaping materials, as water department may need access for repairs. You will be charged for replacement of the transmitter if it is destroyed.

Grass should be no higher than 8" and noxious weeds should be kept trimmed to keep them from spreading.

Please keep your property neat and clean for your own benefit as well as for the residents and visitors to our town. The village is working hard with our legal team to get eyesores fixed up or torn down, but funds are limited so it is a slow process. We should all take pride in our village.

In Illinois, **it is illegal to put grass clippings onto any public roadway as it may cause injury to motorists or become a traffic hazard.** If caught by the state, you could face big fines. A first offense littering charge would land you a \$1,500 fine. A third offense could mean a \$25,000 fine.
