ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS: If you see something that creates a nuisance or a violation, such as unlicensed or non-running vehicles parked in yards, accumulations of trash and/or appliances, weeds or tall grass or other eyesores that make our Village look bad, please contact Village Hall – 697-0137 so we may take steps to correct it. According to the Municipal Code of the Village, the only thing you can burn is yard waste....grass clippings, weeds, twigs and fallen limbs as an example. You **CANNOT** burn couches, chairs, mattresses, construction materials, styrofoam, fiberglass or anything that creates a foul odor or puts pollutants into the air. You will be fined if you burn these items. **DO NOT BURN** if there is a burn ban in effect or if the wind is over 7 mph as fires could quickly get out of control.
