- a) Liquor License for the Corner Farm

Carolyn, of the Corner Farm stated that they have twelve parties a year that they need a license for and that there would not be an open bar. Debbie Herrold asked if there was going to be a poll of the neighborhood. There was discussion about having a public meeting or circulating a petition but no decision was made. The Clerk explained that should the village grant a liquor license, it is contingent upon the State issuing a license as well. If the State withholds a license for any reason then the village license will be revoked. The Village will also need proof that the Corner Farm has dram insurance. Patty Monks asked if they were going to be carding for minors and Carolyn said that yes, they do card.

Alice Daily asked where a pre-annexation grants an alcohol license and a building permit in writing. Our attorney explained that it puts them first in line in order to be annexed if that becomes available and puts them under the jurisdiction of the village. Liz Rensch asked how we can give a license to a property that is zoned A1 and not commercial. That was deferred to the main meeting.

Liz asked Carolyn why they want to come into the village other than the liquor license. Carolyn stated that Peoria County said they didn't need a liquor license but the woman who told her that is no longer working for the County. Debbie Herrold stated that she had been told they couldn't get a license from the county because of a lawsuit. Carolyn said that was not true, that there is no lawsuit with the county.
