**If your water bill is not paid by 8 AM on the 21<sup>st</sup> of the month, you will receive a shutoff notice stating that if it isn't paid by the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup>, depending on the way the calendar falls, your water will be shut off. This is an automatic process for all residents with unpaid balances. You have until the date on the shutoff notice to take care of your bill and to avoid shut off. You will also receive a phone call at least 48 hours prior reminding you! Call the water chair, Liz Rench (309) 360-6047 if you have questions.**
