Beginning October 24, 2021, you must dial 10 or 11 digits (area code + telephone number) for all local calls. On or after this date, local calls dialed with only 7 digits may not be completed, and a recording will inform you that your call cannot be completed as dialed. You must hang up and dial again using the area code and the 7-digit number or 1+ area code and the 7-digit number or 1+ area code and the 7-digit number. Beginning July 16, 2022 dialing “988” will route your call to the National Suicide Prevention and Mental Health Crisis Line.
