Terms are expiring for three Village Trustees and the office of Village President (Mayor) in spring 2021. Trustees manage village property, finances, safety, health, comfort, and general welfare and leadership of the town. Candidates must be a Village of Mapleton resident one year prior to the Consolidated Election and be a registered voter and at least 18 years of age.

The trustee positions and the Village President are for 4-year terms. Candidates can pick up petitions and packets beginning September 22. Petitions must be signed by registered voters. The petitions must be filed on December 14 at Village Hall.
