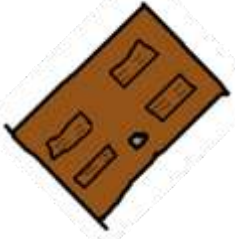
HOLLIS TOWNSHIP SENIOR POTLUCK

BEHIND THE FENCE AT THE WATER TOWER ON MONK'S LANE

The Village of Mapleton will have a dumpster available for disposal of large, hard to get-rid-of items. **Resident use only.** Please be considerate and place items at the back of the dumpster until it is filled.

Gates will be open from 9 AM to 2 PM on Saturday and Sunday (if any room is left) and will be manned by trustees and other volunteers.

You will be required to give your name and show ID to prove you are a resident of the Village of Mapleton.
